New Business

Edison Local School District – Superintendent Cory Ream & Dave Frank discussed the possibility of Edison School district tapping into the Village of Milan sewer system if the district builds a one campus school, to include elementary, middle school, and high school out in the township. They discussed the potential of Edison Local Schools, the Township and Village entering a Joint Economic Development District (JEDD), which allows for the levying of an area wide income tax and the provisions of public improvements and municipal services in unincorporated townships lands located within the JEDD. They requested for the Village to consider this and continue conversations with them and the Township.

Website Content Archiving Policy – It was discussed to amend the Personnel Policy, Chapter 12, Public Records Policy, to include a new Section 6, Website Content Archiving Policy. Administrator Rospert will send out the updated Personnel Policy to Council and put this on the April Council meeting agenda.

Open Positions Electric & Streets – Administrator Rospert informed Council there has been three applications received for the Street Department. The candidate for the electric position has turned down the position due to insurance. Council would like to have the benefits included in the advertisements for the Electric and Street Department.

Other – Fiscal Officer asked Council to consider the support of UAN visiting clerk, Diane Schaefer on, as an as needed basis at \$25.00 an hour. Council agreed to utilize Diane for her UAN support.
