Council Work Session for the Village of Milan Council was called to order by Mayor Pam Crosby on June 11, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Room at 11 S. Main Street, Milan, Ohio.

New Business

Huron Street Complaint – Administrator Rospert spoke on the quote for speed bumps and speed tables that would cost the Village \$3000.00 - \$10,000.00 apiece. Erie County Regional Planning Kevin Cannon would put to use a traffic counter through them for the Village, to track the traffic count in the areas of concern. Administrator Rospert will contact Kevin Cannon to have traffic counter count traffic on Huron, William & Merry Streets and Edison Drive.

Clothing Allowance – Council discussed Village of Milan logo t-shirts, polos and cardigans for Village employees. Council's decision is, Village employee men will receive 2 t-shirts and 1 polo each, with 1 t-shirt given every year thereafter. Village employee women will only receive a one-time Council purchase of 1 cardigan and 1 polo each, with nothing the following year(s).

Other – Solicitor Barney will draft an Ordinance to include Elm Street Water Looping Project from Capital Improvement Fund.

Unfinished Business

Tax Budget documents were put on the drive for Council's view. The Tax Budget Hearing will be scheduled for Thursday July 9th at 6:15 p.m. with a Special Council Meeting scheduled for Thursday July 9th at 6:30 p.m., on the agenda will be legislation for the Tax Budget.

Questions for Next Meeting

Concerns regarding e-bikes and scooters that are in the roadway are going through stop signs and are not obeying the laws. It was noted that anyone on the roadway, whether riding a bike, e-bike, scooter, walking, running, etc., shall abide by the traffic laws.

Fiscal Officer said there were no updates on healthcare, but she will follow up with Tom Forester.
